HELPING PARENT AGREEMENT

As a requirement of the Cooperative, parents are called upon to fill the position of "Helping Parent" at specific times during the school year. This is scheduled via a rotating list, created by a Cooperative committee. Student birthdays are scheduled as one of the Helping Parent days during the school year. Helping Parents are required to submit a health form and a Tuberculin (TB) test prior to their first scheduled day as Helping Parent.

On their scheduled day, the Helping Parent is considered an employee of B.C.N.S. and needs to arrive at the Nursery School at 8:45 am, prepared to assist the teachers as needed. Their child will be the "Captain of the Day". NO SIBLINGS ARE ALLOWED ON THIS DAY.

The Helping Parent shall be required to donate a snack, beverage and needed paper goods for the class on their scheduled dates. Students with food allergies or questionable food issues may be requested to provide their own snacks on a daily basis.

If a Helping Parent is unable to help as planned on their scheduled day, it is that Parent's responsibility to get another Cooperative parent to substitute. If a substitute is not obtained by the scheduled date, it is necessary to contact a Co-President, as soon as possible. On the first occurrence, the scheduled parent will be fined a \$25.00 fee, payable to the Nursery School. If there is a second occurrence, the B.C.N.S. Executive Board will have no choice but to follow the policy written in the B.C.N.S. By-laws.
